- NEW! Environmental Development Plan (KEVAD) until 2030

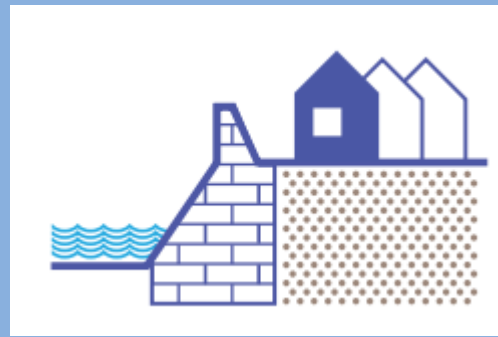

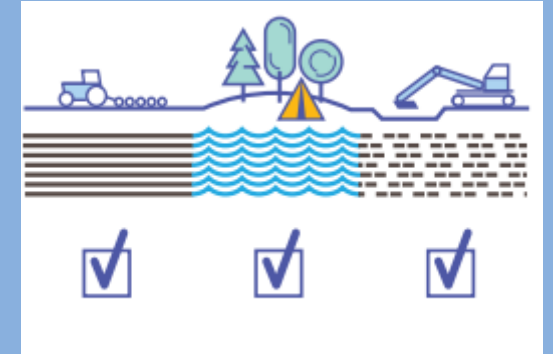

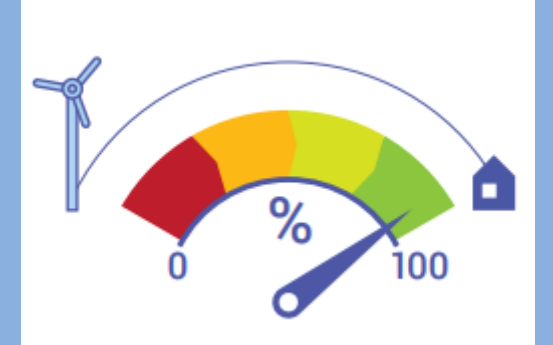

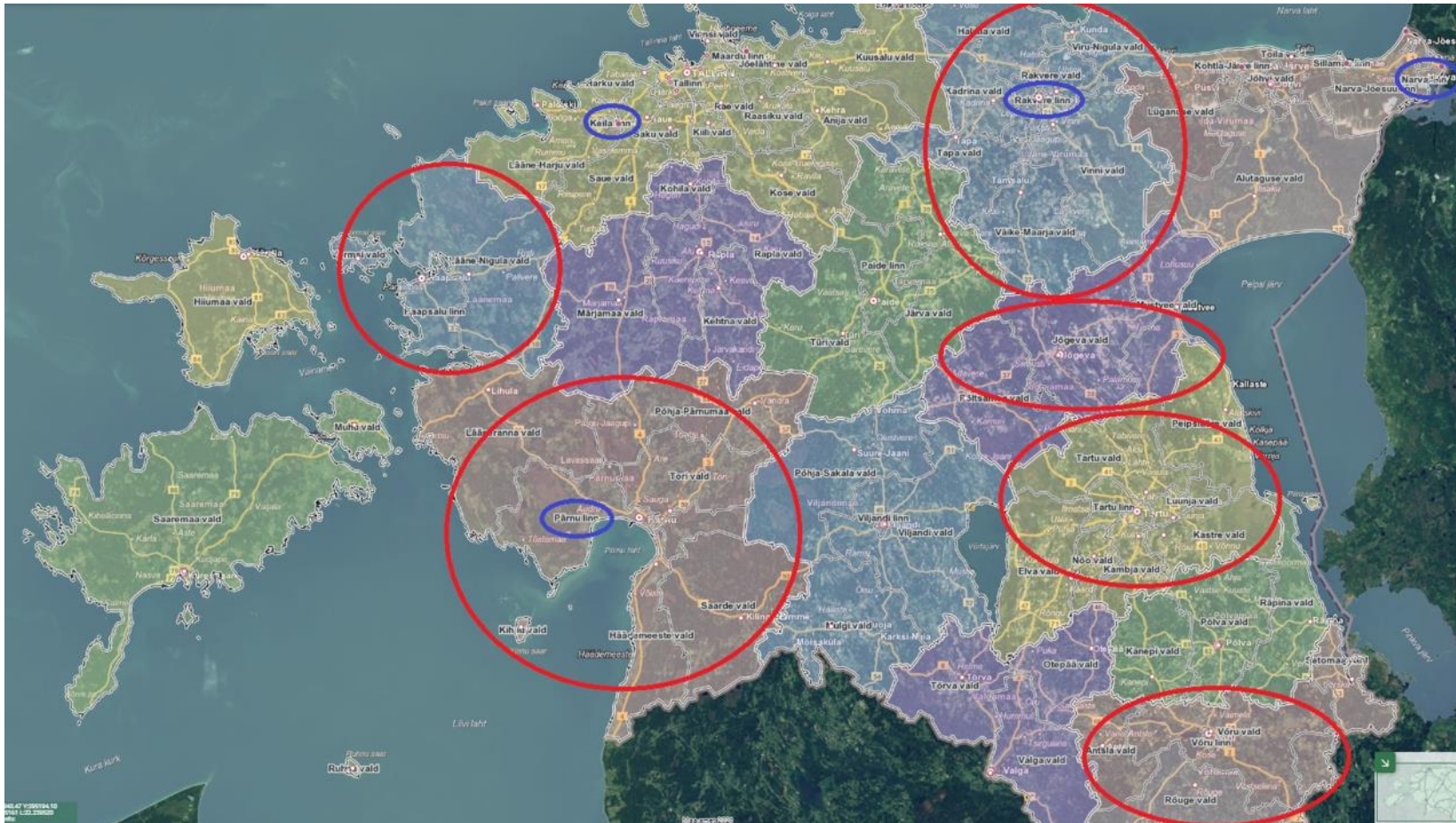

- Call: 26/2/2022-26/4/22
- Budget: 0,4 M euros
- 19 applications were submitted
- 10 of them were granted (6 countys and 4 cities)

Coverage of Climate and Energy Plans in Estonia

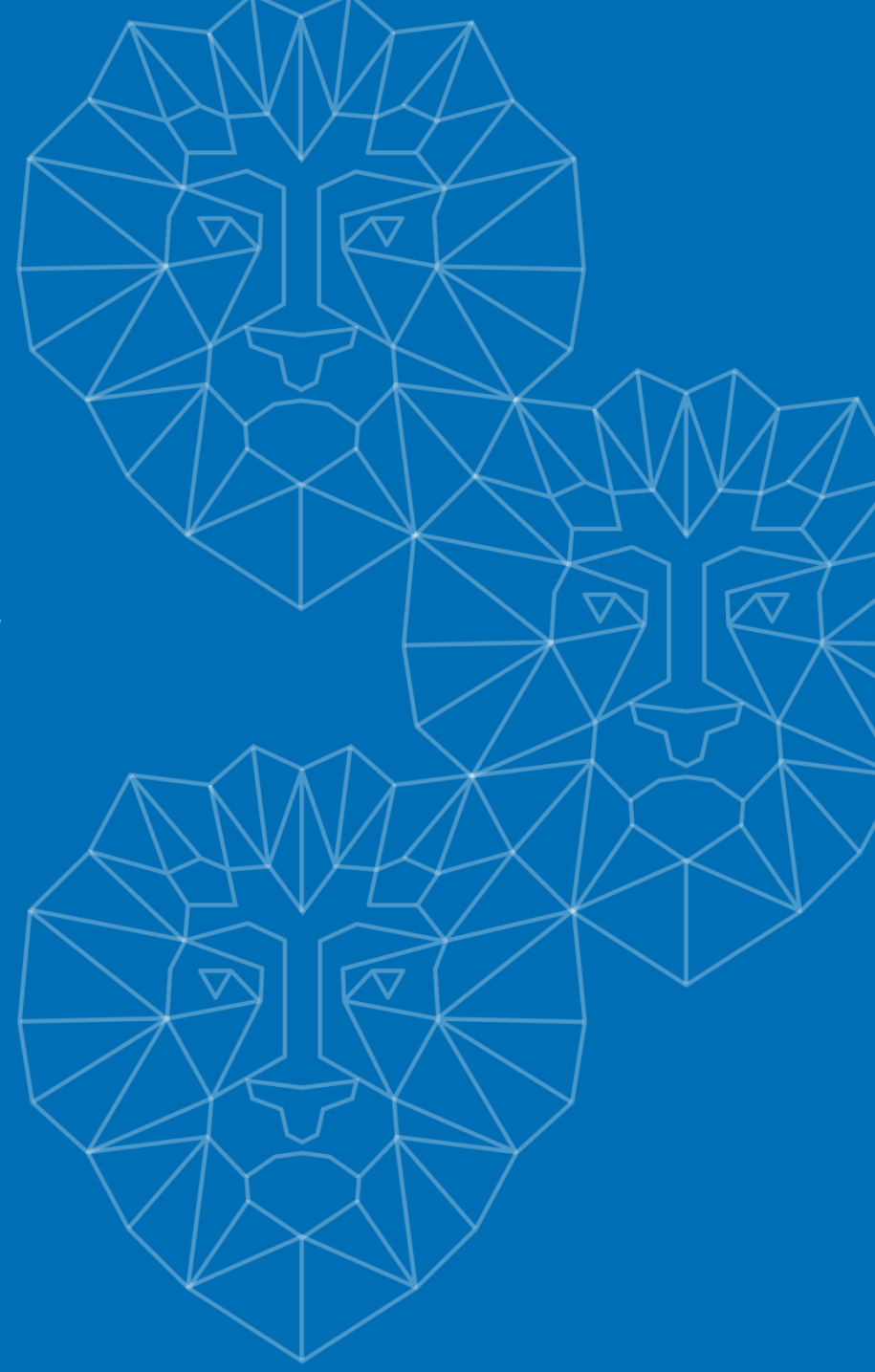


Lessons learned from previous Grant Scheme

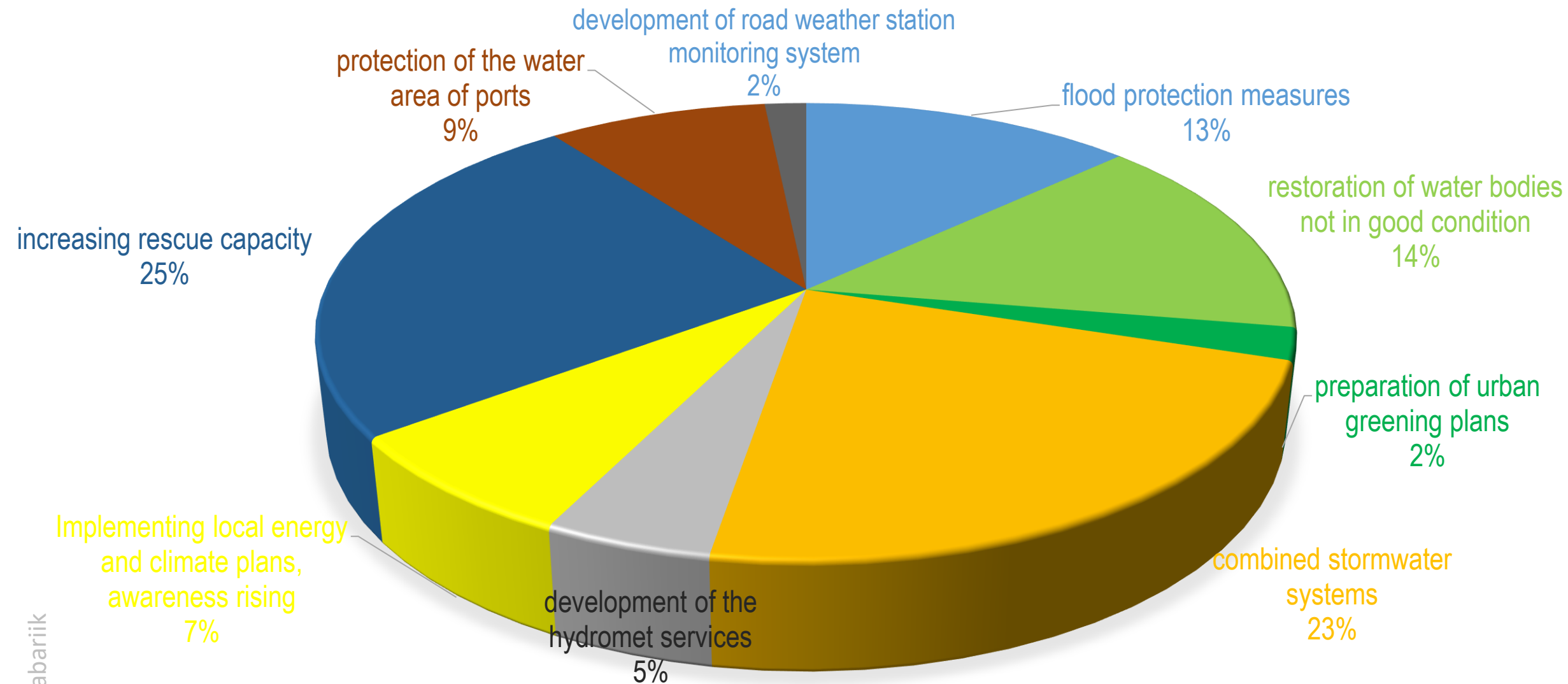
- ? Climate data availability

Adaptation funding in period 2023-2027 - 110 million euros from the SF funds
